Prenatal Care	Prenatal care in first trimester or within 42 days of enrollment: documentation of when prenatal care was initiated with OB practitioner (fetal heart rate, fundal height etc.); documentation of any one of the following: OB panel, torch antibody screen, rubella antibody titer with Rh incompatibility, or ultrasound of pregnant uterus; documentation of LMP or EDD with either a completed obstetrical history or risk assessment & counseling/education	
Postpartum care	Postpartum care: within 21–56 days from delivery date; documentation must indicate evidence of pelvic exam, examination of breasts, abdomen, weight & blood pressure or notation of “postpartum” visit/care	A claim for a PAP smear completed within 21-56 after delivery counts as a post partum visit if coded with 88141-88143, 88147, 88148, 88150, 88152-88155, 88164-88167, 88174, 88175
