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**Family Planning**

Suffolk Health Plan does not provide certain family planning and reproductive health services such as birth control services, prescription birth control, sterilization and abortion. You do not need a referral from your PCP to get these services. You can get these services from any doctor or clinic that provides them and who takes Medicaid. Your clinic, doctor or drug store will bill the State directly using the Client Identification Number (CIN) on your Suffolk Health Plan Family Health Plus card. You may also need to show a CBIC, or "Benefit Card" if you have one. **HIV Counseling and Testing**

Suffolk Health Plan does not provide certain family planning and reproductive health services. If you want HIV testing and counseling as part of family planning services, you can get these services from any doctor or clinic that provides them and who takes Medicaid. Your clinic or doctor will bill the State directly using the Client Identification Number (CIN) on your Suffolk Health Plan's Family Health Plus card. You may also need to show a CBIC, or "Benefit Card" if you have one. If you have any questions or need information about these non-covered services, you can call Suffolk Health Plan's Member Services Department at (1-800-763-9132). You can call the New York State Growing Up Healthy Hotline at 1-800-522-5006 for information on where to get these services.

If you want HIV testing and counseling but not as part of a family planning service, your PCP can arrange it for you. Or you can visit an anonymous HIV testing and counseling site. For information, call the NYS HIV Counseling Hotline at 1-800-872-2777 or 1-800-541-AIDS.

If you need HIV treatment after the testing and counseling service, your PCP will help you get the follow-up.

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
